

## HE. WE. THEY. Prayer Stations

# HE

### PREP

Have Super Sticky Notes in the shape of the word HE posted on the wall (use a color that is in contrast to the wall color). Have skinny markers, pens, or pencils available for children to use.

### SAY

Everyone take your hands and lift them up towards (what we think) is heaven. When we lift our hands toward heaven today, we are focusing our attention on Jesus. Everyone do this with me and say, 'HE.'

In just a moment, I am going to read some scripture and we are going to read part of The Lord's prayer together. I want us to focus on Jesus and give Him praise this morning by removing a sticky note, writing or drawing a praise to Him on a sticky note, and putting it back onto the wall. Before you put your praise on the wall, I want you to pray your praise to Jesus.

### READ

Psalms 150:6

Let everything that breathes praise the Lord.

Hallelujah!

Matthew 6:9-10 "Therefore, you should pray like this:

Our Father in heaven, Your name be honored as holy.

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

### LEAD

Invite children to write a praise to Jesus. His name is Holy, set apart, and worthy of our praise. Model or help children as needed.

# WE (Provision)

## PREP

Have a simple snack available for kids to eat and drink.

## SAY

Everyone take your hands and point your hands and arms toward yourself as you are kind of pointing to yourself.

In just a moment, I am going to read some scripture and we are going to read part of The Lord's prayer together. I want us to focus on needs we have and taking our requests and needs to Jesus. Did you know Jesus wants and will provide for us. He may not be so worried about providing us with goldfish or animal crackers, but He promises to always take care of us.

## READ

Philippians 4:19

God will supply all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus.

Matthew 6:11 Give us today our daily bread.

## LEAD

Take a few moments to enjoy the snack and remind children that although this verse says daily bread, it's not just talking about literal bread or even food. Although it talks about our needs like daily bread, we also need so much more- like the Lord to lead us and guide us. This addresses physical needs like food, shelter and clothing and it also talks about spiritual food- our relationship with Jesus. If you want to know more about following Jesus or you feel Jesus is asking you to follow Him, talk to me, talk to Mrs. Jan, talk to Pastor Randy, and especially your parents today. Don't leave church without talking to someone today.

# WE (Purification)

## PREP

Have red plates, white hearts, writing utensils, and tape ready

## SAY

Everyone take your hands and point your hands and arms toward yourself as you are kind of pointing to yourself.

In just a moment, I am going to read some scripture and we are going to read part of The Lord's prayer together. I want us to focus on sin for a bit. Jesus came to die for our sins. Sin is anything that displeases God. God is holy and He cannot be in the presence of sin. We need to be aware of our sin and we need to ask forgiveness for our sins. When we are saved and follow Jesus, we have to admit that we are sinners. God's Word tells us all have sinned. All of us. We have to say I'm sorry and ask Jesus to forgive us.

## READ

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Psalms 51:9-10 Turn your face away from my sins and blot out all my guilt. God, create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Matthew 6:12 And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

## LEAD

Show them your heart plate. Tell them that you prayed and asked God to help you think of a sin that you need to ask forgiveness for and you took a heart and wrote it on the back (a picture can be drawn as well) turn it over and write your name on the front of your heart, then glue your white heart to your red plate with only your name on it. Tell kids that we can pray and ask God to reveal sin in our lives and He will. Also tell them that He will forgive you of your sins if you ask him to. When Jesus died on the cross, his blood was the payment for our sins and when we follow Jesus, He washes us white as snow and He remembers our sin no more.

# WE (Protection)

## PREP

Have fence, ribbons, and Sharpie Markers available for kids to use

## SAY

Everyone take your hands and point your hands and arms toward yourself as you are kind of pointing to yourself.

In just a moment, I am going to read some scripture and we are going to read part of The Lord's prayer together. I want us to remember that we can pray for protection. Just like a door or gate with a lock can protect us from outside harm, Jesus wants to protect and care for us. His Word tells us to draw near to Him and He will draw near to us. He also tell us to trust in Him when we are afraid. God's protection is much stronger than any door or gate, but today, we are going to write or draw our worries or fears and tie them to this gate. May this be a visual reminder that Jesus protects us. Let's ask Him to protect our brains, our eyes, our ears, our hands, our feet, our thoughts, our bodies and to help us when we are afraid.

## READ

James 4:8a Draw near to God and He will Draw near to you.

1 Peter 5:8a Be serious, be alert, the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion.

Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will trust in You

Matthew 6:13a And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one

## LEAD

Show the kids the gate. Remind them a gate is meant to keep unwanted things out. Let's write or draw the things that scare us or tempt us on our ribbons and tie them to the gate. While we tie them to the gate, let's pray and ask God to help us when we are afraid and to help us realize that we need to focus our minds on Him so temptations have no place in our lives.

## HE. WE. THEY. Prayer Stations

# THEY

### PREP

Have the world map and pictures ready. Ask the kids to pray for each of the focal points on the continents and to put one dot each time they pray for that area. You can choose one area to focus on or highlight each and ask the kids who they want to pray for.

### SAY

Everyone take your hands and point your hands out toward others. We are going to focus on THEY. They represent others who need Jesus and those who are taking the news of God's love and Jesus to others so they can know and trust Him.

In just a moment, I am going to read some scripture and we are going to read part of The Lord's prayer together. I want us to understand that if we love Jesus, then we need to pray for others. We need to pray for THEY. Today let's learn about others who share Jesus with those who need Him.

### READ

Matthew 28:19-20 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.

Matthew 6:13b For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

### LEAD

Tell the children we are going to pray for those who need to hear about Jesus and for those who are telling others about Jesus. Remind them that they need to also live in a way that glorifies Jesus so others will want to know and trust Him. Let's pray for these people who are sharing Jesus all over the world and let's pray for people to hear about Jesus and that they will want to know, love, and serve Him.
