

From Worship to Influence

Worship flows from God, to God, and through you to others.

Worship is not just an activity—it is a movement. It begins with God, shapes us inwardly, is expressed upwardly, and ultimately flows outwardly into the lives of others.

**IUO is the direction of worship.
LLL is the flow of influence.**

The Flow of Worship

INWARD (From God)

God forms the worshiper. He shapes the heart, renews the mind, and establishes identity.

UPWARD (Toward God)

Worship is expressed to God through praise, thanksgiving, and devotion.

OUTWARD (Toward Others)

Worship flows beyond us and multiplies in the lives of others.

**Inward worship forms the leader.
Upward worship expresses the leader.
Outward worship multiplies the leader.**

How to Move People Through the Flow

INWARD — FORMATION

- 1 Share the gospel clearly and personally
- 2 Teach foundational truths of the faith
- 3 Establish simple spiritual disciplines (Word, prayer, obedience)

UPWARD — EXPRESSION

- 1 Teach what praise is and why it matters
- 2 Help them learn to praise privately first
- 3 Give permission and language for public praise

OUTWARD — MULTIPLICATION

- 1 Create clear opportunities to serve
- 2 Train them to share their faith simply
- 3 Teach them to pray for and minister to others
