The Widening Circle

“Your Kingdom come. Your will be done.”

Over the past six weeks, you have been learning to slow down, notice God, commune with Him, surrender your life more fully, and develop rhythms of whole-life worship.

But true worship never stops with us.

The Worship Circle keeps widening.
Worship overflows.

As hearts awaken to God,
their lives begin influencing others.
Homes change.
Churches grow stronger.
Communities feel the impact.
And the worship of God continues spreading outward.

The Worship Circle keeps widening.

Jesus taught us to pray:
“Your Kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.”

This means worship is not merely personal.
It’s also participational.

God invites us to join Him in praying for:

- spiritually lost people,
- churches,
- leaders,
- communities,
- revival,
- unreached peoples,
- and the nations.

As worship grows within us, our hearts begin expanding toward the things that matter to God.

This week, spend time praying beyond yourself.

Pray for people who do not yet know Christ.
Pray for churches to become alive with genuine worship.
Pray for pastors and leaders to walk closely with God.
Pray for worship to spread throughout cities and nations.
Pray for spiritually hungry hearts to awaken.
Pray for God’s glory to be known among all peoples.

God is drawing hearts to Himself.

And He invites us to participate through prayer.

Guided Prayer

Begin by praying personally:

“Lord, continue shaping my heart.
Teach me to love You fully.
Help me live a life of whole-life worship.
Keep the fire of worship alive within me.”

Now slowly begin expanding your prayers outward.

Pray for others:

“Lord, awaken the hearts of people around me.
Draw my family and friends closer to You.
Help me carry the fire of worship into my everyday life.”

Pray for your church:

“Lord, strengthen Your Church.
Raise up worshipers who love You sincerely.
Bring unity, humility, truth, and spiritual renewal.”

Pray for your community:

“Lord, let Your presence be known in my city.
Help people see Your goodness and truth.
Let worship overflow into homes, schools, workplaces, and neighborhoods.”

Pray for spiritually lost people:

“Lord, open blind eyes.
Draw people to Christ.
Reveal Your love and truth to those who are far from You.”

Pray for revival:

“Lord, awaken Your people again.
Stir hearts toward repentance, holiness, and worship.
Let spiritual fire spread throughout Your Church.”

Pray for unreached peoples and the nations:

“Lord, let the nations worship You.
Reveal Yourself among every tribe, tongue, and people.
May Your name be known throughout the earth.”

As you pray, remember:

- The Worship Circle keeps widening.
- Worship overflows.
- God is drawing hearts to Himself.
- Whole-life worship influences others.
- We are called to carry the fire.
- Your Kingdom come.
- The nations will worship.

Go Encouraged

You do not need to become famous to influence others for God.

Faithful worshipers quietly shape the world every day.

As you continue walking with God,
loving Him,
obeying Him,
and praying for others,
your life will naturally influence people around you.

Never underestimate what God can do through one surrendered worshiper.

Keep walking closely with Him.

Keep returning your attention toward Him.

Keep carrying the fire.

And remember:

The Worship Circle keeps widening!
